



# Button Hole Crochet Scarf

## Pattern and Instructions

### Materials needed

Size F or G crochet hook  
150 yards of worsted weight yarn  
sewing needle and thread  
decorative button



No gauge is given for this pattern. Consistent tension is more important than gauge in this project.

Chain 16

chain 1 and turn

\*single crochet in first chain

single crochet each stitch in row 1

chain 1, turn\*

Repeat between \*s for 12 rows

chain 3, turn

Row 13

\* double crochet in first stitch and for the rest of the row to the end

chain 3 and turn\*

repeat for 36 rows or until you have reached approximately three inches shy of the desired length of the finished scarf.

Chain 1 and turn

Row 37 single crochet each row as you did in rows 1 through 7.

(sc for 7 rows)

Row 44 single crochet for 6 stitches

chain 4

rejoin row at stitch number 10 and single crochet 6 stitches to the end of row

This will create the button hole for closing the scarf ends



Row 45 Single crochet rows 45 through 49 (chain 1 at the end of each row for turning) Pull yarn through the last loop to finish. Weave in the ends.

Finishing

Block your finished scarf to help it lie flat

Attach the button

Congratulations!

**Finished scarf is approximately 24.5 inches long and 4 inches wide.**

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
